



ALMOND SPECIFIC PRODUCE SAFETY ALLIANCE GROWER TRAINING COURSE

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Almond growers or farm-type operations (huller/shellers)... even if you will be utilizing the grower exemption.

The course will provide a foundation of Good Agricultural Practices (GAPs) and co-management information, FSMA Produce Safety Rule requirements, and details on how to develop a farm food safety plan, specific to almonds.

After attending the entire course, participants will be eligible to receive a certificate from the Association of Food and Drug Officials (AFDO) that verifies they have completed the training course. To receive an AFDO certificate, a participant must be present for the entire training and submit the appropriate paperwork to their trainer at the end of the course.

- \$35 registration fee, which includes lunch and certificate at completion of the training.
