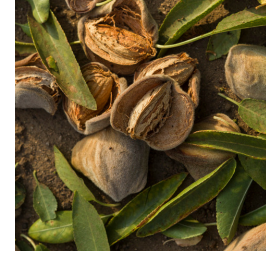

- **Apr 22** Ballots Mailed to Independent Growers & Handlers. Election Voting Begins.
- **May 23** Last Day for ABC to Receive Signed Ballots. Election Voting Ends.
- **May 24** Ballots Counted. Election Cycle Ends.
- **Jun 1** Election Results Announced.
- **Aug 1** New Terms of Office Begin.
